Instruction:	Teaches ESL (English as a Second Language) and Reading, primarily through one-on-one tutoring, but also has a Conversation Café class.
Fees:	FREE
Contact:	Phone and email are the best methods of contacting.
Restrictions:	Must live in Western Cook County and be at least 18 years old.
Locations:	Instruction occurs in local libraries.
Times:	Once per week for about one and a half hours until student reaches ninth grade level.
Levels:	Students who function below a ninth grade level.
Wait time for tutor:	Depends. If there is a wait, it is usually no longer than three months.
Tutors:	Tutor training occurs four times a year. LVWCC usually maintains about 200 instructors.
Students:	200-250, on average.
Speakers Available:	Yes.
